ABOUT THE SERVICE

WALK-IN SERVICES:

This service can be availed of by an animal owner by bringing the sick animal to the City Veterinarian's Office for consultation and treatment.

REQUIREMENTS

None

FEES

- Consultation Fee : Free
- Medicines and biologics are subject to availability of supply or as prescribed

HOW TO AVAIL OF THE SERVICE

Schedule: 8:00 am to 5:00 pm – Monday to Friday

FOLLOW THESE STEPS	IT WILL TAKE YOU	PLEASE APPROACH
1. Bring in animal for consultation Visit or call OCV	1 minute	Clerk
2. History Taking Client waits while history taking and physical exam of the animal is conducted	5 to 15 minutes	Veterinarian or Technician On Duty
3. Treatment If the condition is manageable, treat animal. Treatments depend on availability of drugs. If not, then drugs are prescribed.	10 minutes	Veterinarian or Technician On Duty
4. Livestock Consultation Farm clients may visit or call OCV for consultations. If field visitation is required, then proceed to area. Service is dependent on availability of transportation	5 minutes to 1 hour	Veterinarian or Technician On Duty

ISSUANCE OF VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE

ABOUT THE SERVICE

For purposes of trans-island shipment, any animal owner may request for the issuance of a Veterinary Health Certificate

REQUIREMENTS

- Current rabies and vaccination certificate

SLAUGHTER OF ANIMALS FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION

ABOUT THE SERVICE

The OCV handles the slaughter house operations for the slaughter of and the production of meat fit for human consumption.

REQUIREMENTS

- Certificate of Ownership of Large Cattle
- Certificate of Transfer of Large Cattle
- Barangay Certificate / Clearance
- Veterinary Health Certificate from point of origin or shipping permit if coming from outside of the city

Schedule:

Acceptance : 6:00am to 7:00pm – Daily (including Saturdays, Sundays and Holidays)
Slaughter Schedule: 12:00 midnight to 6:00am – Daily

FOLLOW THESE STEPS	IT WILL TAKE YOU	PLEASE APPROACH
1. Bring in Animal Animals should be brought in at least six (6) hours prior to scheduled slaughter. Animals are recorded	5 minutes	Guard / Watchman on Duty
2. Ante-Mortem Inspection Animals are inspected for any signs of disease or condition which would warrant condemnation	5 to 15 minutes	Meat Inspector

3. Slaughter The animal is then slaughtered.	20 minutes to 6 hours	Butcher
4. Post-Mortem Inspection Animals are inspected for disease which would warrant condemnation	5 to 10 minutes	Meat Inspector
5. Issuance of Meat Inspection Certificate Meat Inspection Certificate is issued for posting at the Market Stalls	5 to 10 minutes	Meat Inspector

RABIES PREVENTION, CONTROL AND ERADICATION

RABIES VACCINATION

ABOUT THE SERVICE

WALK-IN SERVICES:

This service can be availed of by an animal owner by bringing the animal susceptible to rabies to the City Veterinarian's Office for vaccination against the disease.

MASS RABIES VACCINATION:

This service can be availed of if there is one laboratory confirmed positive Rabies case in the area.

REQUIREMENTS

FOR WALK-IN CLIENTS:

- Animals must be three (3) months of age
- Healthy

FOR MASS VACCINATION:

- One (1) laboratory confirmed positive case of rabies

FEES

WALK-IN CLIENTS:

- Rabies Vaccination P 50.00
- Registration Fee 10.00

MASS VACCINATION: Free

HOW TO AVAIL OF THE SERVICE

Schedule: 8:00 am to 5:00 pm – Monday to Friday

WALK-IN CLIENTS

FOLLOW THESE STEPS	IT WILL TAKE YOU	PLEASE APPROACH
1. Vaccine Availability Call office to inquire about vaccine availability	1 minute	Clerk
2. History Taking Client waits while history taking and physical exam of the animal is conducted. If animal is healthy for vaccination then it is vaccinated after payment of fees.	5 to 15 minutes	Veterinarian or Technician On Duty
3. Payment of Fees OCV issues order of payment and instructs the client to pay at the City Treasurer's Office the required fees.	2 minutes	CTO Collection Clerk
4. Recording and Vaccination Client presents the Official Receipt and records in the logbook the required data. Animal is then vaccinated.	5 minutes	Clerk and Veterinarian / Technician on Duty
5. Issuance of Vaccination Certificate Client is issued the Vaccination Certificate	1 minute	Clerk

FREE MASS RABIES VACCINATION

FOLLOW THESE STEPS	IT WILL TAKE YOU	PLEASE APPROACH
1. Inform the OCV Any positive rabies case or suspicious case involving an animal bite should immediately be reported to the OCV	1 minute	Clerk
2. Epidemiological Survey Client is interviewed as to the facts surrounding the case and investigation is conducted on the circumstances surrounding the case.	15 minutes to 3 days	Veterinarian or Technician On Duty
3. Scheduling Barangay Officials and Barangay Health Workers are informed of the schedule in order for them to disseminate the vaccination schedule and designate vaccination centers within the barangay.	1 day	Clerk
4. Vaccination After having established the need for mass vaccination, OCV personnel	5 days	Clerk and Veterinarian and OCV Personnel

conduct vaccination within one kilometer radius from the affected area. Animals are brought by the owners to the designated vaccination centers for vaccination and recording		
5. Information Dissemination OCV conducts information dissemination and Education Campaign after the mass vaccination.	3 days	City Veterinarian and OCV Personnel

STRAY ANIMAL CONTROL

ANIMAL APPREHENSION

ABOUT THE SERVICE

Pursuant to the “Rabies Prevention, Control and Eradication Program of Silay City”, the OCV regularly conducts stray animal impoundment. Aside from the regular stray animal apprehension, any resident may report to the OCV the presence of stray animals near their area. Apprehended animals are kept for three (3) days only.

REQUIREMENTS

- Presence of stray animals
- Call requesting for the service
- Letter-request from Homeowners Association

HOW TO AVAIL OF THE SERVICE

Schedule: 8:00 am to 5:00 pm – Monday and Tuesday

FOLLOW THESE STEPS	IT WILL TAKE YOU	PLEASE APPROACH
1. Request Call office to report the presence of stray animals/	1 minute	Clerk
2. Apprehension Caller may wait for the OCV Personnel unless he/she intends to remain anonymous. OCV Personnel proceeds to the area for apprehension if animal is still around.	5 to 30 minutes	Apprehending Team
3. Impounding Apprehended animals are brought to the City Pound	5 to 30 minutes	Apprehending Team
4. Recording Pertinent data are recorded	1 minute	Clerk
5. Destruction	15 minutes	Veterinarian or

REDEMPTION OF IMPOUNDED ANIMALS

ABOUT THE SERVICE

Pursuant to the “Rabies Prevention, Control and Eradication Program of Silay City”, any stray animal owner may redeem the apprehended animal upon payment of the necessary fees and penalties.

REQUIREMENTS

- Proof of ownership
- Payment of fees

1. Check with OCV Client checks with OCV to validate apprehension and ownership of the impounded animal	1 minute	Clerk
2. Payment OCV issues Order of Payment	1 minute	CTO Cashier or Collection Clerk
3. Vaccination Animals are vaccinated prior to release	5 minutes	City Veterinarian or Technician on Duty
4. Release After presentation of Official Receipt, recording and vaccination, the animal is released to the owner	5 minutes	OCV Personnel
